AMI FUN-PARK Playroom General Rules of Use

- Using the Ami Fun-Park in a responsible way helps users avoid potential injuries.
- The users are solely responsible for using any of the Ami Fun-Park features.
- The users are solely responsible for the accuracy of the data provided in the Non-Liability Disclaimer and for the adequacy of their signatures on such a disclaimer.
- The Ami Fun-Park offers no babysitting services and assumes no liability for it.
- All users of the Ami Fun-Park shall follow the instructions provided by the staff.
- The users shall adapt their activities to their own abilities and the physical limitations of their own bodies.
- The hotel staff reserve the right to limit the access to the facilities for persons who are not in the right physical or mental state for their use (age, height, etc.).
- Before entering the Ami Fun-Park, the users shall remove all jewellery and other objects which may injure them or other users.
- No food or drinks are allowed.
- The use of mobile phones, cameras or videocameras while using the facilities is prohibited.
- Running is not allowed at the Ami Fun-Park, as well as pushing or disturbing other persons in any manner, be it physically or verbally.
- The Ami Fun-Park is first and foremost designed for the use of children aged 4–17.99.
- Children aged 4–6.99 may only use the Ami Fun-Park **under the supervision of their parents**.

- Children aged 0–3.99, special needs children, and children who do not speak the language needed to communicate may only be present at the Ami Fun-Park <u>accompanied by their</u> <u>parent(s)/guardian(s) who are actively watching them</u>.
- The Ami Fun-Park may only be used wearing socks and dry clothes (by children and adults).
- No more than 50 children may use the Ami Fun-Park at the same time.
- The playroom/hotel is not liable for any lost, missing or stolen items.
- The playroom/hotel is not liable for any damages caused by children using the playroom, and especially for any harm or injury resulting from improper, unsafe or reckless use of the facilities, any harm or injury caused by one child to another, or any consequences of contracting any disease, etc.
- The playroom/hotel shall regularly inspect and maintain all facilities so as to ensure the highest possible safety standards.
- The playroom/hotel have the right to request any person who is not adhering to the rules to exit the premises.
- If a child disturbs other children or endagers their safety, the user is required to pick up their child at the request of staff.
